Effective September 15, 2008, the Youngstown Parrot Head Club is officially a non-profit corporation registered with the State of Ohio! This is the first step in acquiring 501(c)(3) non-profit status with the IRS. Both incorporating and obtaining 501(c)(3) status will better enable us to raise money for worthwhile causes. The application to apply for 501(c)(3) status is 28 pages long, and is quite involved, so if anyone knows of an accountant that may be able to help us file the application with the IRS, please let a board member know.
