## 2nd annual Cornhole Classic and Chili Cook-off planned

The second annual Cornhole Classic and Chili Cook-off is planned for Saturday, October 11, 2008 at the Creekside Golf Dome in Girard, OH. Last year's inaugural event raised over \$4100 for the Beatitude House, and we are confident that we can raise even more money this year.

This year's featured entertainer is none other than K.D. Moore! Parrot heads are sure to be familiar with K.D. and his work. He has recently been traveling the country performing with the best harmonica player on the planet, Greg "Fingers" Taylor. The YPHC is proud to announce that K.D. will be playing a solo show from 2pm—4pm. Other entertainment will be provided by the YPHC's own "Fuzzy Coconuts," as well as other local bands and DJs.

Raffle tickets are available for \$5 each. Winner gets choice of 4 Cleveland Browns tickets or 4 Pittsburgh Steelers tickets. Game dates will be determined later. Cornhole registration is \$50 per team of 2, and the top three teams will win cash prizes based on number of teams participating. Cornhole sign-in is at 10am, and the tournament begins at 12 noon. Chili registration is \$35, and includes admission to the day's events for up to 4 chili team members. Chili setup and sign-in is at 9am, and cooking begins at 10am. Spectator tasting starts at 11 am, with judging by local celebrity judges is at 1pm. The judges' top choice wins possession of the official Youngstown Chili Cook-off traveling trophy, with 2nd and 3rd places winning plaques. Chili cook-off participants must provide a minimum of 5-10 gallons of chili, as well as their own heat source. Electricity will not be available at the Golf Dome, so propane turkey fryers work great!

Spectators are welcome to sample chili and watch the cornhole tournament for just \$5 per person. The Golf Dome will have food and beverages available throughout the day, and there will be other attractions for spectators to enjoy.
